Saturday **18 July 2026**, from 1pm, with an afternoon tea afterwards

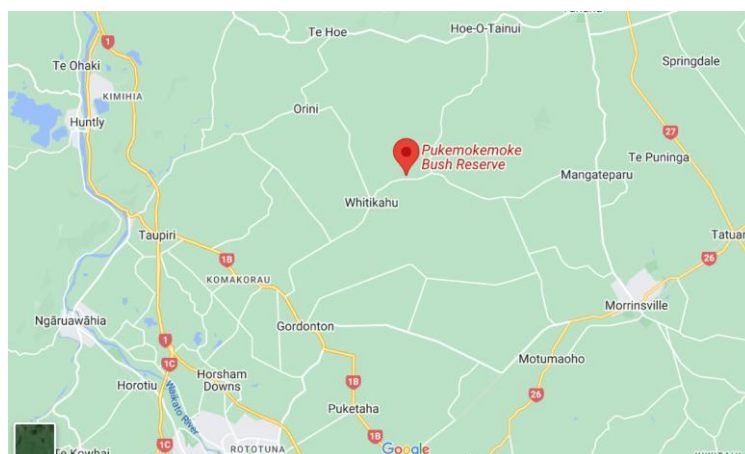
Who: Everyone welcome, bring the family and friends
